Andy's Angels is a Worthing based registered charity (No:1194694), with a purpose to provide a Grief Play Café, as a safe space for children and their families to go to while they are navigating their way through their grief journey.

Andy's Angels was founded in June 2021 by mother and daughter Kayla and Millie.

Millie's dad, Andy died suddenly on the 28th September 2017 when Millie was only 7 years old, with a lack of support for young children within their local area, Kayla and Millie set up a Grief Play Café to fulfil the gap for bereavement support for children and young people.

Andy's Angels has a strong Trustee Board with an enthusiastic and experienced Operations Team. The Grief Play Café is supported and run by Lived Grief Experienced Volunteers and is supported by 3 Ambassadors and a team of Youth Ambassadors.

The charity is keen to support as many bereaved children and young people as they can, no matter who they have lost and offer alternative activities to build confidence and self-esteem.

For some families Andy's Angels is their lifeline, somewhere where people can understand and relate to their feelings, with supportive guidance and educational mental health support for their children and young people.

If you have experienced the loss of a loved one, it is a long journey and we are sure you can understand the need for this support. Please help us continue to offer our Grief Play Café for our local community by organising your own fundraising events, to not only raise much needed funds but to raise the charity's profile within the wider community.

Planning your fundraising event

Thinking about organising a fundraising event?

We are here to help!

1. Decide on how much money you would like to raise, it is always good to have a goal.
2. Make a list of all the things you enjoy doing or are really good at, from making lemonade, baking, card making etc. Write them all down and choose a fundraising idea from here. Don't worry if you get stuck, we have a few ideas included in this pack.
3. Where, when and why? Look into a suitable venue/space for your event, decide on a date and time that will capture the most footfall, think about why you are raising funds. (Don't forget to check and see if there are any other events that will clash with yours) Remember if it is in a public open space, you will need to get permission from the local authority.
4. Get others involved, if it is an event on a slightly bigger scale, you might need a team of you working on different aspects of the event such as: venue/food/raffle prizes etc
5. Make a list of where to advertise your event, Workplace- in the staff room, Community Centre- on their community board, in the newspaper!! Then utilise our Fundraising Event Poster included in this pack to promote your event, make sure the poster is clear about who you are raising funds for, how and details for the event, make sure you have an end time, otherwise people might be there forever 😊
6. Don't forget if you are doing a sponsored event, there is a sponsor form included in this pack.

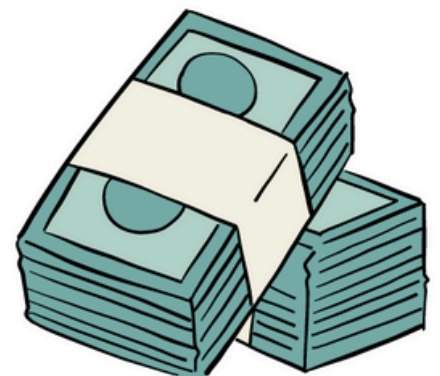
